

YOUTH SUMMER CAMP RULES

1. Stay with the group at all times.
2. Your involvement is required in all camp activities including ALL services, prayer times, team competitions, group times, meal times, and cabin clean up. No one is allowed to leave any of these activities early or arrive late.
3. The counselor is in charge. If a challenge arises, please communicate respectfully with your counselor.
4. During camp students will have limited cell phone usage only during free time. The goal for each of our students is to unplug from their normal routine and connect to God and community.
5. If any inappropriate content is shown on a phone or device, it will be confiscated and be returned to a parent or guardian upon Drop-off.
6. You are only allowed in your cabins during designated times. You can never be alone unless permitted by a counselor.
7. No inappropriate contact allowed, including PDA. You are not allowed in the cabins of the opposite sex.
8. If the following items are found on you, it may result in being asked to leave camp, at the youth pastors discretion: Cigarettes, Vapes, Alcohol, any other intoxicating or mind-altering substance, handguns and or other weapons.
9. No pranks allowed.
10. Respect all camp property.
11. Have fun! These rules are ultimately to help keep attendees safe and create the best camp experience.
