Matthew 9:35-38

Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the **good news** of the kingdom and **healing** every disease and sickness. When he saw the crowds, **he had compassion** on them, because they were **harassed and helpless**, like **sheep without a shepherd**. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

What does this passage of scripture show us about Jesus?
